

2018 March 1st - “The Chronic Intestinal Failure Action Day”

March 1st 2018 will be the 4th ESPEN “CIF Action Day”, the database for Chronic Intestinal Failure promoted by the HAN & CIF special interest group of ESPEN.

Within March 15th 2018, Centers that participated in the CIF Action Day in the previous years will receive the database for the 2018 data collection.

The results of the data collection in the first 3 years was as follows (provisional data)

2015: Contributing centers 65, Countries 22, Patients 3239 (adults)

2016: Contributing centers 81, Countries 24, Patients 5369 (adults and children)

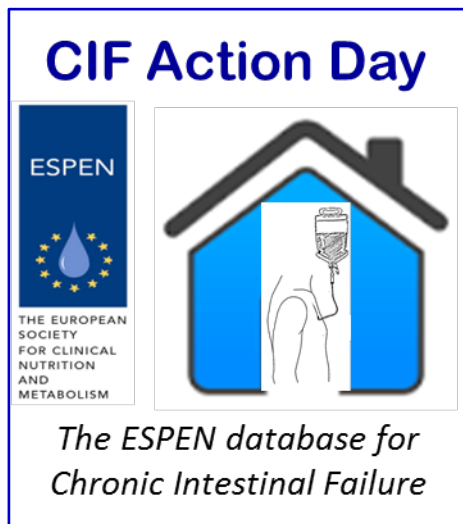
2017: Contributing centers 79, Countries 25, Patients 6598 (adults and children)
